How to vote

ASTC members will vote for their preferred nominees at the AGM on Wednesday 14th November 2018, 7:30pm AEDT. The AGM will be held online. More information will be provided to members via email.

Conditions

Nominees must be current financial members of the ASTC at the time of the AGM.

Nominees must be proposed and seconded and the nominee must agree to stand.

Nominations may be received before or at the AGM. However, we recommend returning the nomination form well before the AGM to enable nominees to be listed on the ASTC website. This will allow voting members an opportunity to consider all candidates, and in case of unforeseen technological issues, ensure that your nomination is accepted in a timely manner.
